GARY COOLING CENTERS AVAILABLE CITY REMINDS RESIDENTS OF IMPORTANT INFORMATION DURING EXTREME HEAT CONDITIONS

Gary, Indiana-With temperatures soaring into the high 90's this week, city officials continue to remind residents of important information during extreme heat conditions. The City's Cooling Centers will be available for residents who may need relief from the hot weather.

Residents are also reminded to check on senior residents and family members regularly. Anyone aware of persons living in vacant structures are asked to report the situation to City Hall to (219) 881-1311 or via email at mocs@ci.gary.in.us. Residents may also visit the city's website at www.gary.in.us. "Click" on Report a Problem.

The Gary Health Department has released a list of the city's cooling centers that are open daily. **A list of cooling centers open daily is below.** The Gary Public Safety Facility and all Gary Fire Stations are available for brief/transitional relief from hot weather.

Cooling Centers-Extended Hours-On an as needed basis

Residents should call 219-881-1214 after regular hours if in need of a cooling center after hours. Extended cooling centers are available on an as needed basis.

After Hours/Weekends Emergencies

Residents should call 219-881-1214 for hot weather related Emergencies.

Residents may go to the Public Safety Facility, 555 Polk Street or to Gary Fire Stations for brief/transitional relief from hot weather. A cooling center or facility will be identified as needed for long or extended stays.

Residents may visit the beach from 8:-00 a.m.-8:00 p.m. at Lake Street and from 8:00 a.m. -9:00 p.m. at Marquette Park. Residents should be mindful that <u>Life Guards are on duty from 10:00 a.m.-6:00 p.m.</u> All are encouraged to exercise beach safety and not go in the water when lifeguards are off duty and when no swimming signs or red flags are posted. Neighborhood pools are open at Tolleston, Reed, Roosevelt & Buffington Parks.
